Over the past 5 years there have been more blood moons and harvest moons than in times past. People have been buzzing about the significance and meaning behind these apparent 'Signs of our Age'. While there remains a bit of controversy over prophecy and when the eventual End will come, we can all be assured that God is true to His Word.



April 8th, 2024 Total Solar Eclipse/The Franklin Institute

In total, there have been or will be 3 lunar eclipse blood moons and one penumbral lunar eclipse micro full moon with a gray to gold hue due to the Earth's shadow within the 2 year window of these solar eclipses. Certainly, this qualifies as a unique event. It seemed people were expecting the eclipse itself to be some cataclysmic event as when Jesus died upon the cross and Noah arrived in Nineveh. It's important to remember that these are signs and there are messages that can be extrapolated from the paths of totality. But the event itself was otherwise uneventful.

In the Old Testament, the prophet Joel prophesied, "The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the LORD." (Joel 2:31) This verse indicates that we can expect a blood moon and a solar eclipse before the Lord returns. It's important to recall that a tetrad of blood moons also occurred in 2014-2015. For this reason, pastors, theologians, scientists and lay people have observed that there is a greater frequency of these phenomena. Many religions and folklore attribute meaning to blood moons and solar eclipses when celestial bodies and planets align. Thus various people-groups will train their eyes on the sky. Arguments and speculation abound. Some reason that Jesus is returning for a spotless bride. Their argument rests upon this reasoning since the Church is not spotless, rather far from it, thus Christ is not coming back any time soon. This reasoning is based on fallacious assumptions that are not written in the Bible. The Bride will never be spotless and can never be until she meets the Bridegroom in the sky. Saints, "see that no one deceives you," but also that you do not deceive yourselves.

Lately, people have been quoting the Scripture verse, "You will not know the hour or the day" (Matt 24:36) warning others not to be focused on a day or when the rapture will come. Yet in the previous verses leading up to verse 36, Jesus said this:

By these signs you will know that the time draws near. "Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place." — Matthew 24:32-34

The Word is saying that the generation that was alive to see the beginning of sorrows, the birth pains, the signs in the firmament, the drying up of the Euphrates River, the breaking off of the continent of Africa, further separating both spiritually and geologically from the continents of Europe and Asia, wars and rumors of wars, rivers turning blood red, appearance of blood moons, preparation of the spotless red heifers (which was cited as Hamas' reason for their October 7th massacre), the development of plans to rebuild the Jewish temple, etc, etc, will not pass away before all of these things take place. You have very clear, objective signs and events foreshadowing the coming of our Lord. All this reporter is surmising is that "the time is drawing near."

Signs in the Heavens

Comets, novas, Northern Lights, and paths of totality for eclipses are all examples of signs in the heavens. I will briefly expound upon a few of these in the following points.

• Comet - The infamous comet known by its scientific designation Comet 12P/Pons-Brooks, was

recently nicknamed the Devil's Comet, because it developed horns from two outbursts on its profile. This 18-mile-wide comet which passes by the Earth every 71.2 years, was visible in our night sky during April, and was closest to the sun on April 21, 2024, and closest to the earth along its trajectory in June 2024. Prior to April this year, it last appeared in Earth's night skies in 1954. The next time it will enter Earth's proximity is in 2095. Originally, the comet only displayed one outburst. In October of 2023 the comet developed the second outburst which coincidentally is when the previous solar eclipse crossed the United States.

• Path of Totality of the April 8th, 2024 Eclipse – One of the most striking signs that God is speaking are the recent and coming Solar Eclipses. On August 21, 2017, a solar eclipse crossed the United States with its path of totality hitting first Salem, OR, and a total of 7 Salem's as it crossed our nation from northwest to the southeast coast in South Carolina.



The Path of Totality of the April 8th, 2024, eclipse crossed 2 Nineveh's and near 5 more Nineveh's just outside the direct path, but more remarkable is that it crossed 26 more cities with the name Salem, for a total of 33 cities biblical-named cities experiencing the Solar eclipse. This reminds us of the 33 years of Our Messiah's earthly life. Salem is the original name of Jerusalem and it's the City of Peace. Originally, Melchizedek King of Salem was first mentioned in Genesis 14:19 when Abram shared the first communion and first tithing recorded in the Bible, aside



Love Letters With God – Jesus Is In Your Morning




When Pastor Justine went back to see Obi and his
