Coming Up @ Your City Council Meeting:

The next City Council meeting will take place on August 15th and has some important topics on the agenda. Here's what to expect:

1.09% Special Sales Tax for School District revisited

During the July 18 meeting, after lots of input from citizens, the City Council decided to abolish a resolution that would have repealed the 1.09% sales tax that the city collects for the Woodland Park School District.

Surprisingly, the issue is back on the agenda for this week's meeting. The City Council is considering putting the question on the November ballot for citizens to decide. If the ordinance on initial posting is approved, a public hearing will be set for September 5th.

Fire Arms on City Property

At their June 27 meeting, the City Council passed an emergency ordinance allowing the legal carrying of firearms in city buildings, City Hall, and the Ute Pass Cultural Center. The emergency ordinance became necessary to beat Senate Bill 24-131 that bans all firearms in "sensitive spaces" and became law on July 1st. The council is now considering a permanent ordinance. In past meetings discussions arose surrounding the question of concealed carrying. If the ordinance on initial posting passes, a public hearing will be set for September 5th.

Public Hearing

Public Hearing will be held on two items this August 15. First is the transfer of the liquor license from Good Thai Eats to Jess Place. Second is the approval of an ordinance revising the city municipal code to regulate noise within the city.

As a community member, we encourage you to attend these public meetings where citizens can voice their concerns during public comment. Also, please email your


As part of the celebration, participants were invited to write prayers and blessings on Post-it notes, which were

This symbolic act infused the new space with positive intentions and hopes for the future.


After the ribbon was cut, students of all grades eagerly explored their classrooms, met with teachers, dropped off supplies, signed up for electives, and

It was very hard for me to meet these cultural Christians who said they were but in reality had not the slightest clue how deep it really is.

The Word 'Christian' has sadly been tainted by believers who don't live like Christ. The lost people will meet these shallow Christians and then attach that wrong image to who God is.
