On September 17, 2024, the US Constitution celebrated its 237th birthday. Organized by the conservative grassroots movement We The People of Teller County, proud citizens met for a flag waving event and brief ceremony at the Lions' Park in Woodland Park. The US Constitution is the world's longest surviving written charter of government. Definitely a fact worth celebrating.



In 1997, Louise Leigh, a retired medical technologist in California in her eighties, started her own grassroots campaign to have Congress recognize Constitution Day as its own national holiday. Leigh was concerned about a general lack of constitutional literacy. In December 2004, Senator Robert Byrd of West Virginia added language to an omnibus bill passed by Congress that established the event today, celebrated on the same day as Citizenship Day. The law requires that each educational institution that receives federal funding shall hold an educational program on the United States Constitution on September 17 of such year. In addition, the head of every federal agency has to provide each employee with educational materials concerning the Constitution on the same day. September 17 also marks the start of Constitution Week. It is crucial that we all know our constitutional rights. As the first Chief Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court, John Jay, said: “Every member


Why am I qualified to demystify your toughest problems and help untangle the tangled up worries and diabolical dilemmas?

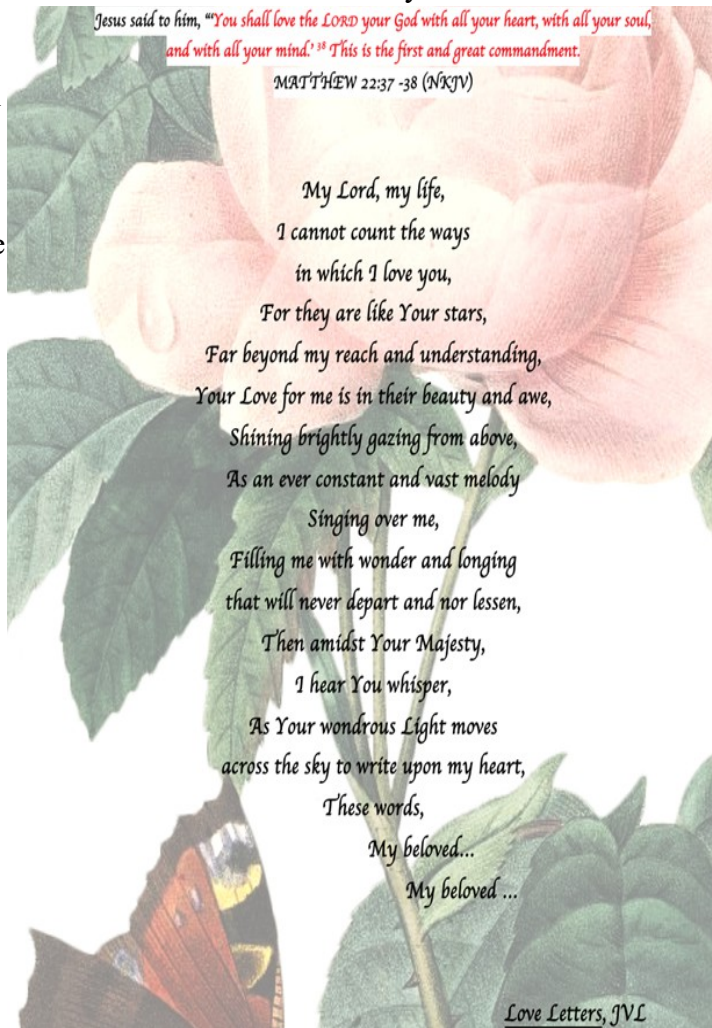
One of my greatest heart longings is to know and experience God’s love. The more my heart would ask God questions about His love, the more I would see His love for me in His Word. I will never forget the night He wrote “Beloved” in my heart. I was outside on our large front porch sitting in my swing looking up at the night sky. This was one of my most favorite places to be – swinging in a large comfortable swing, drawing near to God, and gazing at the beauty of the night sky filled with numerous stars which were far beyond my reach.

I remembered earlier that week I had been meditating on Matthew 22:37-38 (NKJV) where Jesus tells us, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment.” From this commandment I constantly found myself saying “I love you Lord” repeatedly even though at that time I had no idea of the depths of His love for me. How could He love me? I had made so many stupid mistakes in my life. Even though I was still growing in my knowledge of Him I often wondered why would you love me, Lord? As my walk with the Lord has grown, I now realize that He does not love me because of who I am, He loves me because of who He is. God is love. (1 John 4:8) I am also amazed how God continues to tell us about His love for us in 1 John 4:10 wherein He says, “Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.” God loved us so much He sent Jesus to save us. That is more love than I can think or imagine.

As I sat there in the swing whispering, “I love you Lord.” I paused, swung back and forth a few times and then I heard Him say softly in my heart, “I loved you first.” My heart leaped with those words. I started smiling and later my heart must have done a dance when I read 1 John 4:19 which says, “We love Him, because He first loved us.” I have learned that if the Lord speaks to you in your heart His words will always line up with His Word. It is true – He did love you and me first.

For a long time, I just sat there, swinging back and forth, looking at the night sky and then ever so softly the Lord began to write “Beloved” in my heart. One of the most significant aspects I have learned with my love letters with God is that they always start with my heart open and surrendered, I start talking or singing to Him with childlike faith, but He consistently ends the love letter with His words to me. It is always a personal intimate heart conversation. As I began to seek a deeper understanding of God’s love for us, I discovered 1 John 3: 1-3 (NKJV) wherein it says, “1 Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore, the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. 2 Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. 3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.”

I will always remember that night in the swing when I experienced God’s love, not because of who I am, but because in Christ Jesus, as a child of God, I am His beloved. As a child of God, you are His beloved too. Our hope is in Christ Jesus our Lord and from that hope I have found that God’s love flows in the most wondrous ways – even upon the night sky to write upon our hearts to tell us that we are so deeply loved by Him.
