We have the power of our words. So before I delve into this Agreement, let's quickly discuss this amazing season we happen to be in right now. In the last couple of editions of the Kingdom Chronicle, I shared about the Jewish Fall Feasts and the Jewish new year 5784. I want to emphasize the Hebrew meaning of a few numbers in the Jewish year 5784 and our Gregorian calendar year of 2024.

Let's begin with the 80 in 84. This is known as the letter Pey and is represented by the pictograph resembling a mouth. The meaning of the word Pey and the number 80 is mouth, and by extension, "word," "expression," "vocalization," "speech," and "breath." It's important to understand the letter that precedes Pey, which is the letter Ayin meaning the eyes, understanding, and an awareness that comes before verbal expression. The Ayin is known as the gateway to reality, and the Pey or the mouth is what brings reality into being. Just as Ayin or understanding of what we see, not just in the natural but also in the spirit, gives insight, it is Pey or our words that give that insight expression.



Now let's take a look at the number 4 or the Hebrew letter Dalet represented by the pictograph resembling a door.

Reports from the City Council

At their last two regular meetings, the City Council had the chance to review and vote on two very exciting opportunities for Woodland Park.

Avenger Open Space purchase

The Avenger Open Space is a 120-acre plot of land, including a historic mining claim, situated off of King's Crown Road and adjacent to the city-owned Paradise Open Space. It runs through both Teller and El Paso counties and is currently a mixture of both national forests and private property. The Avenger Open Space is loved by many outdoor enthusiasts in Woodland Park for its beautiful trails. A recent survey revealed that over 650 people enjoy the property every week. This property was recently listed for sale presenting a unique opportunity for Woodland Park to preserve the area as an outdoor recreation and wildlife preserve area, but at the same time also a threat of future development, should the property be sold to a new private owner. City Council unanimously approved a resolution for the city to purchase the land including the application for a land acquisition grant from Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO). The grant would cover USD 523,205 of the purchase price with an additional USD 150,000 committed by the city and fundraising in the amount of USD 80,000.

Agreement with Boy Scouts on new reservoir

It is a known fact that Woodland Park has an ongoing water supply issue that has to be carefully evaluated and taken into account with the increasing development of the city. The City Council was able to approve a development agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for the development of the Glen Aspen Reservoir. The project includes the creation of a new reservoir downstream from the current reservoir in turn for the city establishing a larger parking lot and driveway into the property and the Boy Scouts being granted the right to use the reservoir for recreation purposes and receiving water usage rights. The agreement presents a win-win outcome for both sides and a great success for the city of Woodland Park.

Lenten lessons; True Riches

The Pearl by John Steinbeck was our big reading assignment in eighth grade English, and a large portion of one's final grade hung on the attendant term paper we were to write. The book was somewhat accessible for me at that point in my rural, mostly barefoot life. I sensed warnings about greed, but at the same time was inspired by Kino's tenacity in going after what he perceived to be the most important thing in the world. I was also moved by his commitment to those he cared about and his desire to give them something better than what they had.

The book introduced me to John Steinbeck, and I became a fan for life. Years later, when I read that a museum in honor of my literary hero would be established out West, I settled in my mind to one day go. Growing up in the back-roads of North Carolina, a trip to Salinas, California, seemed no less daunting than a trip to Mexico or Norway. Getting there someday became a priority for me, a 'bucket list' item, a highly-sought jewel.

In the Gospel of Matthew, the Bible speaks of the value of finding "a treasure hidden in a field," or the, "one pearl of great price." In these parables Jesus emphasizes that something few people take notice of—the Kingdom of heaven, and one's place in it—is worth forsaking all to attain.



Most everybody knows that "the pearl" of Matthew 13 provided (however loosely) a premise for Steinbeck's shortest book. But in Jesus' story of the quest for life's most priceless pearl, there is no danger of tragedy but only the promise of victory. How? Because in apprehending the true pearl beyond price — a relationship with God — one doesn't *lose* their soul, but actually gains it.

Many forfeit their character for something of this world; Countless souls, past and present, have chosen to opt out from the offer of a city whose gates are pearl and streets are gold (Rev. 21:21). Jesus is telling us that to

invest all in the promised treasures of God is actually the wisest thing we could do.

Necessarily, prioritizing one thing requires backing away from something else. As Lenten season approaches (February 14-March 28, 2024), Christians the world over will be motivated to "take spiritual inventory" and amend themselves accordingly. During Lent, Christians pray and give gratitude to God for salvation through Jesus' death on the Cross. They block out time to read Scripture, doing their utmost to comprehend and comply.

Lent is a time believers give extra diligence to discern what the Holy Spirit is prompting them to do—turn away from sin, cease behaviors and attitudes displeasing to God. Just as Jesus, our Savior (and example), fasted 40 days in the wilderness, Lent is a time to fast 40 days from anything in which we've bestowed love that belongs only to God.

Imagine how quickly, thoroughly, and positively the world would change if we all lived a life of Lent. "Lent" is a word associated with springtime, a fresh start, and the days growing longer and having more daylight. Christ's resurrection is God's guarantee that a new beginning for this world lies just ahead, and our place in His coming Kingdom is secured by putting our faith in Jesus.



Pearls, they say, are the jewels created through suffering. The treasures Jesus offers us were purchased through suffering as well. In this world it is tempting to give up hope, but Christ is as close by as a prayer! Tangible change in our lives *can* happen, and lasting peace and joy are possible! Through Lent we turn away from a fallen world and allow God to change our sinful nature. We recommit ourselves to that most worthy quest, the pursuit of God Himself.

Two School Board Meetings Held on December 13th and January 10th

On December 13, 2023, the community gathered for the first meeting of the newly constituted school board. Keegan Barkley replaced David Illingworth as director for District C. The atmosphere among the public attendants was positively expectant and respectful. It was the first meeting in a long time without disrupting comments and reactions. David Rusterholtz handed over the mantel of president of the board to Mick Bates, whose first action was to distribute handouts on the public participation at board meetings. Bates expressed his wish for school board meetings to become more orderly again. The board in turn made a visible effort to have more open discussions on agenda points during the meeting, responding to the public's request for more transparency in board decisions. Chief Academic Officer Kim Moore informed about the current enrollment numbers to be certified. In total, the WPSD has 1,820 full time students enrolled, which is about 200 students short of the budgeted number.

CFO Amy Ryan presented the Fiscal Year 2023 independent audit conducted by Tom Sistare of Hoelting and Company, Inc. No issues were identified during the audit and the respective documents can be found on the district's website under financial transparency. The board then briefly discussed the planning of the biennial board retreat and training session, which takes place after every major election. Superintendent Witt invited the board members to forward suggestions on potential facilitators before the January 10 board meeting. The January 10 meeting was off to a rocky start. Several public comments criticized the surprising announcement that High School principal Kevin Burr was let go on the Friday before the christmas break, only days after the last school board meeting. This refueled the calls for more transparency and public involvement in the school board

and superintendent's decisions. Newly elected board member Keegan Barkley then claimed that she was not involved in President Mick Bates' appointment of Cassie Kimbrell, a mother of a special needs child herself, to the Ute Pass BOCES Board. Bates responded that Barkley was "a very hard person to reach", a comment that was met with much indignation from the public. The board moved on to the discussion on the planned board retreat, with Barkley suggesting her own facilitator, which was not submitted in time for the board members to properly consider. A misunderstanding on Barkley's side. The board decided to hold the public retreat on February 24, 2024, from 9 AM – 12 PM at the Cathedral Pines Lodge in Colorado Springs, with Ross Izard as facilitator.

The next controversial topic on the agenda was the potential renewal of the superintendent's contract. Whereas four of the five board members voiced their support for Superintendent Witt, Barkley wanted to at least explore the possibility of a search for a new superintendent. President Bates informed that a search for a new superintendent involves quite a financial commitment with no guarantee of success. In the past, basic searches created costs of at least USD 11,000. Barkley was convinced to be able to do this cheaper if not for free and offered to help the board with her expertise in this area. The board decided to reconvene for a Special Board Meeting and Executive Session on January 17, 2024, to discuss the different options and if possible vote on the way forward.

The meeting concluded with the presentation and vote on the mill levy certification and the 2023-2024 revised budget.

The next Regular School Board Meeting will take place on February 14, 2024.

Our Triple Billion targets outline an ambitious plan for the world to achieve good health for all using science-based policies and programs."

The WHO Pandemic Agreement

This agreement was originally a treaty, and all treaties require ratification through our U.S. Senate. The Biden administration requested that it be renamed an agreement rather than a treaty, which can be adopted without Senate Consultation. This is a blatant move to completely circumvent our constitution and constitutional process. Thankfully, this has been met with opposition. Rep. Chris Smith (R-N.J.) called the treaty/agreement "an egregious breach of constitutional principle." Rep. Andy Biggs (R-Ariz.) has introduced the WHO Withdrawal Act (H.R. 79), which would end the U.S. membership with WHO, repeal the legislation authorizing our WHO membership in 1948, and ban U.S. funds from WHO projects. The latest donation numbers I can find from the WHO website state, "The USA has been one of WHO's largest donors for many years. In 2020-21, it was the third largest, having invested approximately US\$ 700 million." That is in addition to the annual membership and an additional "\$280 million contribution to support critical work to help end the COVID-19 pandemic, strengthen public health systems, and provide urgent relief," announced December 2021. This is a concern because this move by the Biden administration essentially undermines national sovereignty by coming under an unelected (by the American people) global authority and circumvents our constitutional oversight and checks and balances.

On - Page 4, point 9 of the WHO Pandemic Agreement it reads: "9. Reiterating the need to work towards building and strengthening resilient health systems, with skilled and trained health and care workers. to advance universal health coverage and to adopt an equitable approach to mitigate the risk that pandemics exacerbate existing inequities in access to health services," Although global universal health coverage sounds good, are we really ready to hand over our healthcare and coverage to a global system that would dictate everything from the top down without any say at all from the people? This could potentially mean that chiropractors or natural healthcare providers who take a different approach could be deemed unnecessary or worse. Or any allopathic medical doctor who just happens to have a difference of opinion for that matter. We actually saw a small glimpse of this with the Covid-19 pandemic. There was massive censorship of well-respected medical doctors and natural health practitioners who had a different yet highly successful approach to treating patients than what was

pushed down from the WHO. As Americans, I think we sometimes are so used to the way things are for us that we don't really understand how good we have it. We have so many options when it comes to healthcare. Our biggest limitation might be determining which healthcare providers that our insurance covers. For most Americans, we have options of insurance as well.. Now I am not saying our system is perfect or without flaw by any means. What I am saying is that in America we can choose to opt out of the mainstream if we want, and we have a plethora of options to choose from. Because there is no one size fits all health care it is important to have those options. I appreciate that we have the freedom to visit the doctors and receive the treatments we trust and are comfortable with. I would be very sad to see that all go under the control of a global agency that does not abide by our same constitutional values and liberties. As we saw with covid-19, a treatment/ medicine that was quite effective in treating the virus was made unavailable to the public. That is not acceptable in the slightest, and under this agreement we will be sure to experience much more of that. That leads me to my second concern under the "Use of Term" section.

On - Page 5 WHO Pandemic Agreement we see: "(c) "infodemic" means too much information, false or misleading information, in digital and physical environments during a disease outbreak. It causes confusion and risk-taking behaviors that can harm health. It also leads to mistrust in health authorities and undermines public health and social measures;". Ignorance is NOT bliss and for any global agency to take away the right to information will always lead to a take away of truth. This is a very slippery slope. Personally I am not at all interested in an unelected, unAmerican, ungodly organization that is set up with its own constitution and declaration telling us what information we are allowed to have access to? Isn't it the American way to be free thinkers and have the freedom to trust the medical professionals and resources we are most comfortable with? This agreement will strip every American of access to information and resources to make informed decisions for ourselves and our families regardless of the truth.

Although this is not the last of my concerns with this agreement, it is the last one that I will share here.



For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord.

For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways

and my thoughts than your thoughts. Isaiah 55:8-9

Every individual inherently possesses the ability to form opinions on a multitude of matters. There's nothing wrong with this, provided those opinions align with the wisdom of God. As the scripture in Romans 3:4 asserts, "Let God be true and every man a liar." This biblical reference underscores God's unwavering faithfulness to His promises, irrespective of human fallibility. God's commitment to fulfilling His promises remains steadfast, and it's incumbent upon us to accept these promises through faith and obedience to His instruction.

The tale of Naaman, a well-known biblical character, vividly illustrates the common flaw within human nature—a heart consumed by pride. The scripture says, "Knowledge puffs up" (1st Corinthians 8:1), and this epitomizes Naaman's struggle. A decorated warrior, he had triumphed in numerous battles, possessing a wealth of knowledge. However, this very knowledge almost jeopardized his desired deliverance. Afflicted with leprosy, he sought a cure from a prophet in Samaria. Yet, when given what he deemed an undignified instruction, his pride obstructed his healing. Naaman, convinced he knew better, expressed disappointment and anger at the instruction. "I thought for sure he would stand in front of me and pray to the Lord his God, then wave his hand over my skin and cure me. What about the Abana river or the Pharpar river? Those rivers in Damascus are just as good as nay river in Israel. I could have washed in them and be cured." – 2nd Kings 5:11-12. Eventually, after his pride had been appeased, he did as he was told, and was healed.

While it's easy to judge Naaman for his pride and ignorance, many of us have displayed similar moments of pride, believing certain tasks are beneath us. Reflect on instances when you might have dismissed something seemingly insignificant — that was your Naaman's moment. Those most affected by their pride are often those who believe they've attained significant knowledge or success. However, as mentioned in 1st Corinthians 1:27-31, "God chose the foolish things of the earth to shame the wise. God chose the weak things of the world

to shame the strong. God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things, and the things that are not – to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before Him." (NIV)

Similarly, the Jews' failure to recognize Jesus as the Messiah stemmed from their misconception of His nature. They anticipated a regal, powerful figure, yet Jesus, born in humble circumstances, defied their expectations. Their rejection of Jesus, despite scriptural prophecies, led to their inability to receive the promised Messiah. This rejection continues to impact Israel's current state. They failed to grasp that God fulfilled His promise in a way contrary to their expectations.

Moving forward, whether in the coming year or in the years to follow, God still chooses the foolish, weak, lowly things of this world, and the things that are not to nullify the things that are. We must therefore remain vigilant to recognize God's work in unexpected ways. Recall the Syrophoenician woman, relentless in seeking healing for her child; despite Jesus' initial response, which seemed dismissive, her unwavering faith led to her child's healing, earning Jesus' commendation for her great faith.

CALL TO ACTION

As this new year begins, bearing in mind that previous expectations might not have materialized in 2023, let us, like Elijah's servant, "go again." Yet this time, let us approach it equipped with God's word, relying on faith, obedience, and prayerful discernment. Let God choose how He wants to answer that prayer. He is God all by Himself, and it is in our best interest to let Him do as He pleases. Be attuned to unexpected sources — be it a janitor, a garbage collector, a homeless individual —who might convey a message with profound significance. If it looks beneath you, it's most probably God. And if it seems too good to be true, it's most probably God as well. Heighten your discernment. One never knows if these seemingly ordinary or extraordinary encounters may harbor a divine purpose, potentially delivering the blessing one anticipates. That lowly individual might be your angel on assignment. And that "beneath you" instruction might be the open door to that miracle you so desire. Let the Lord do it as He pleases!
